From the Vicarage:

'Into Holy Week ... onto Easter'

The week preceding Easter brings with it a multitude of emotions as we journey with Jesus through the events remembered in **Holy Week** to the victory and celebration of **Easter Morning**. These events are at the very heart of our faith. A friend asked recently "Which is the biggest God Gig? Christmas or Easter?" It was asked with genuine interest and my response came without hesitation.

Countless people have been born and then died, but Jesus is the only one who chose to die and then came back to life again. If He hadn't fulfilled the journey of Easter then there would be no hope, no salvation, no new life, no *eternal* life and no freedom! ^{1Cor15:14}

Easter Joy comes out of pain and suffering and many are asking deep questions right now. Where is God in this painful world? Where is God in the pain of environmental destruction? Where is God in the pain of sickness? The Lord is here, right in it with us. Because of these events He feels our pain, knows our anguish and understands our humanity ... because of Jesus. In this Holy week we remember that Jesus went to the pits of hell on our behalf ... but He didn't stay there. Sunday is coming.

I encourage you to draw yourself into the account of the events of Holy Week. These days changed the history of the world. It is so easy to let what took place in these crucial days before Jesus' death to pass us by as we look to the celebration of Easter Sunday, but the celebration and the joy and the <u>Victory</u> of Easter Day is diminished when we allow this to happen.


There is no shortage of opportunity for us to engage as a church and that starts this Sunday – April 2nd as we gather together for our Benefice celebration of **Palm Sunday**. Come and join the Maundy Thursday Supper at St Oswald's in Askrigg at 6:15pm then remember the Last Supper as we share in a simple communion service at 7:30pm. Join us on Good Friday morning at Gayle Chapel at 10:15 for a Walk of Witness around the town. Reflect on the trial and the sacrifice at 11:30am in St Margaret's. Bring the family for a walk from Semerwater shore to the Old Cross at Stalling Busk at 2pm and then share in Hot Cross Buns in St Matthew's at 3pm. Then we wait ... and in the waiting we can remember and in the remembering we can give thanks for all that was done on our behalf that day. Sunday is coming.

The JOY of the Victory of Easter Morning can never be understated. The power of death and hell is defeated - 'Love has Won'*

Easter Morning will begin with our usual **Daybreak Service** on the shore of Semerwater where we will be celebrating that life with Fish and Bread, just as Jesus did. Easter Communion will then be celebrated in every church building through the day. As we walk the way of the Cross, may we know the presence, the peace and the hope that is bound within it. And for when the day arrives
