From the Vicarage: 'Into Lent'

How interesting to note that this edition is number 100

Number 1 was printed, (sanitised) posted and emailed out on the very first Sunday of the very first 'Lockdown' in 2020. We have all changed a great deal since then, but praise the Lord that Jesus remains the same: '... yesterday, today and forever' Heb. 13:8

February this year holds several significant dates in the church calendar. Feb 2nd sees the celebration of <u>Candlemas</u>, February 13th is <u>Shrove Tuesday</u> and Feb 14th is the start of <u>Lent</u>. All will be marked in their own special way and we hope that you will be able to attend, enjoy and appreciate them as they are.

Our February 'Gathering' at St Oswald's will mark 'Candlemas' as we also celebrate the baptism of Charlie Arthur Rucroft. Charlie is Elizabeth Fawcett's grandson and it's a lovely combining of dates as many of our younger members will remember Elizabeth walking them down towards Mill Gill to 'plant' candles amongst the snowdrops in the woods to mark Candlemas. Candlemas recalls the presentation of the baby Jesus by Mary and Joseph in the Temple according to the custom that 'every first born male is to be consecrated to the Lord'Lk2:23

Whilst there, they are greeted by Simeon who has been promised by God that he will not die until he has physically seen the Messiah for himself. Overjoyed he holds Christ in his arms and says the words we now know as the 'Nunc Dimittis'. "Lord, now let your servant depart in peace according to your word." Simeon prophecies over him saying he will be a light for <u>all</u> people. Jesus goes on to affirm that He is the 'Light of the World' and that we are also called to be the same. Matt.5:14

What a privilege to be called into that same life changing, world transforming mission of Jesus; to be alive *in* Christ, knowing who we are *in* Christ and living in the power *of* Christ. To do so fully we all need to pay attention to making sure that we know the wonderful promises of God revealed to us through His word. *'The word of God is living and active'* Heb.4:12



The Bible in One Year

Having a good working knowledge of the Bible is essential if we are to live our lives as God intended us to. Reading the Bible from cover to cover is something we should all do at least once in our lives (and hopefully many more times than that) But how to begin is the question that prevents most folks from even starting. Last year several members of the church family joined in reading the Bible in one year. We used a wonderful teaching resource from Rev Nicky Gumbel (the author of the Alpha Course) By setting aside just 20-25mins a day you are taken through the Bible in a thematic way, with helpful teaching notes, powerful testimonies and prayers.





Obviously other books and apps are available, but these are the ones that we recommend.

It's not too late to join in! Study books can be ordered through the office for approx. £16, *or* you can download a Kindle version for £6 *or* download the App for <u>free</u> and listen to Sir David Suchet reading it.
