From the Vicarage:

In our last edition, Samantha Amsden shared some thoughts on what it might mean for us to be a 'Living Sacrifice'^{Rom.12:1} and our attitudes towards our giving towards the mission of the Church. We will share more information about this in the months ahead as it is designed to help everyone of us to give financially in a more convenient and efficient way. This will help manage and simplify your financial giving to your church as well as enabling your treasurer to manage the finances much more effectively.

June is often seen as a 'pivot' month as Spring gives way to Summer and the longest day arrives. I love it! In may ways it is a pivotal month for the Church in Upper Wensleydale as well as some key moments take place in our lives together.

The long awaited and very essential preservation work on the **tower** of St Oswald's in Askrigg gets underway. The scaffolding has been erected over the last week and the site is now prepared and ready for the skilled work of our team of stone masons to begin. Thank you for your prayer support over this project as we have encountered significant hostility and opposition along the way. The team from St Oswald's have been incredibly dilligent over the last 10 years as they have sought out the very latest and the very best professional advice regarding the best intervention required. I am so very grateful for all of their hard work and determination to bring this day into reality. Prayers now please for the safety of everyone who will be working on site and often at a great height.

Work on the replacement of the **boiler** in St Margaret's starts this month with Asbestos material being removed and the electrical supply prepared and upgraded. Two new boilers will be installed in July along with a new oil tank.

We celebrated **Pentecost** together as a Benefice in St Margaret's and were able to display for the first time, a lovely set of banners that have been prepared over the last 3 years by Pat Whitehead and a very willing team of ladies, many of whom have never done any work like this before. Thank You! They are a wonderful reminder of the fruits of the Holy Spirit as detailed by Paul in his letter to the Church in Galatia.^{Gal.5:22f}

June 6th will see the 80th commemoration of the **D Day Landings** that were instrumental in bringing an end to the second World War in Europe. Our schools will be visiting our buildings to pray for peace, light a candle and tie a symbolic white ribbon in memory of those who gave their lives. You are welcome to come and do the same.

June 13th sees our **Warden's** renew their vows of service at a special licensing event in St Matthew's Church, Leyburn. We are blessed indeed by our very able team of Church Wardens who work tirelessly on your behalf to enable the smooth operation of worship in our four buildings. They are a particular source of encouragement and support to me. Thank you.

Our Benefice Communion Service will be looking at our Christian responsibilities as we approach a **General Election**. God speaking through the prophet Jeremiah calls the people to pray for the City (the Nation) "*Pray to the Lord for it, because if it prospers, you too will prosper.*" ^{Jer.29:7} It's good to learn, encourage and grow together as the Church in the Upper Dale.

We hope to see you and welcome you there.


Join us for Evening Prayer on a Sunday afternoon!

Day concludes with a Eucharist in Ripon Cathedral with a homily from the Bishop of Ripon, the Rt Revd Anna Eltringham


